

# Pinnacle Country Club Golf Course

## Hole By Hole

### Hole # 1 Par 4

The tee boxes were enlarged to 5,618 square feet. The hole was lengthened 15 yards with the green shifted to the left. Two fairway bunkers were filled in to tempt those wanting to hit with a driver. The existing right greenside bunker was retained and will provide a higher degree of difficulty to the new green location. The new green was enlarged to 4,743 square feet.

### Hole # 2 Par 5

The tee boxes were enlarged to 6,024 square feet and subtly re-aligned. The front portion of the first fairway bunker was removed and a second fairway bunker added to challenge longer hitters. The fairway at the second landing area has been shifted left to yield a better approach into the green. The new green was expanded to 5,711 square feet. A front sand bunker was added to the front right of the green and the back bunker removed.



### Hole # 3 Par 3

The tee boxes have been re-aligned and enlarged considerably to 9,568 square feet. The new green remains approximately the same size at 4,888 square feet but has been positioned at a different angle to the line of play. Two bunkers and chipping areas surround the green.

### Hole # 4 Par 4

The tee boxes were enlarged to 6,924 square feet. The hole was lengthened 20 yards with the addition of a new back tee and by shifting the green back. The fairway was shifted to the right nearer the stream and tee shots landing along the right side of the fairway are rewarded with a better angle into the green. Two fairway bunkers are positioned to define the left side of the landing area. The new green was reduced in length and it comprises 5,530 square feet.



### Hole # 5 Par 4

The tee boxes were enlarged to 6,750 square feet. The hole was reduced in length by 9 yards from a new back tee positioned along the edge of the stream. A new lake borders the right side of the landing area and along with two fairway bunkers a premium is placed on accuracy. The new green was elevated seven feet to improve air flow and measures 4,578 square feet. The elevated surface along with two new greenside bunkers dramatically changes the character of this hole.



### Hole # 6 Par 3

The tee boxes have been re-configured and expanded to 9,487 square feet. The hole increases in length from a new back tee by 13 yards. The new green was expanded to 5,550 square feet. Three new greenside sand bunkers surround the putting surface.

### Hole # 7 Par 5

The hole has been lengthened by 20 yards and new tees measuring 5,210 square feet have been shifted left to create better separation with the 4th green. The large fairway bunker bordering the left side of the fairway has been divided into two bunkers, and a small fairway bunker has been positioned to define what would normally be considered the right edge of the landing area. The placement of this small bunker is intended to influence club selection and shaping of tee shots. Although additional fairway turf exists to the right of the small bunker this is not an intended landing area due to the location of mature trees between this area and the green. The new green has been reduced to 6,076 square feet. A small greenside bunker guards the front right of the putting surface and will typically come into play for those attempting to reach the green in two.

### Hole # 8 Par 4

The hole has been lengthened 43 yards for all players by shifting the green back. The tee boxes were enlarged to 4,950 square feet. The fairway has been widened by removing two trees to the right of the landing area. The new green was enlarged to 5,850 square feet and the approach was designed to accommodate balls rolling onto the putting surface.



### Hole # 9 Par 4

The hole was lengthened 35 yards with the addition of a new back tee. Yardage from the other tees remains approximately the same. The tee boxes were re-configured and enlarged to 6,068 square feet. The cart path has been re-located to the left side of the hole to lessen the danger of tee shots from the 8<sup>th</sup> tee. A new fairway bunker has been positioned nearer the tee on the left side to provide improved strategy. The green was expanded to 5,698 square feet and shifted left. A false front on the green improves visibility from the fairway and will be a concern for players putting to a front pin location from above the hole. A chipping area guarding the left side of the green has been softened.



### Hole # 10 Par 4

The hole has been lengthened 11 yards for the back tee only. The tee boxes were enlarged to 5,424 square feet and shifted to the left to accommodate a new 10,000 square feet putting green. The fairway has been widened at the landing area by removing rough next to the existing bunkers. The green was enlarged to 5,719 square feet and is surrounded by bunkers and chipping areas.

### Hole # 11 Par 3

The tee boxes have been re-aligned and expanded to 10,600 square feet. The new green was expanded to 4,899 square feet and features multiple tiers. Tee shots to the correct level will be rewarded with legitimate birdie putts. Chipping areas have been added to complement the two existing bunkers.

### Hole # 12 Par 4

The tee boxes were re-configured and enlarged to 5,400 square feet. Trees have been removed along the right side of the hole to improve visibility of the fairway and offer more playing options. The existing fairway bunker has been replaced with evergreen trees to help frame the hole. The new green was shifted nearer to the lake and expanded to 5,701 square feet. Three sand bunkers frame the putting surface. A chipping area has been added to the left of the green for those wanting to avoid the lake with their approach shots.



### Hole # 13 Par 4

The tee boxes were re-configured and enlarged to 5,700 square feet. Where possible, the tees were shifted to the left to lessen the angle of the dogleg. The existing creek just beyond the landing area has been replaced with storm pipe to allow for one continuous fairway. The new green has been shaped to better accept long approach shots. The existing left greenside bunker remains and a chipping area has been added to the right of the green. The green has been reduced in size to 6,742 square feet.



### Hole # 14 Par 5

The tee boxes were re-configured and measure 6,475 square feet. A new back tee was added to increase length by 29 yards. The left fairway bunker was removed to create a larger more receptive landing area. The fairway was also widened at the second landing area. The new green remains relatively the same size at 5,487 square feet and was lowered three feet. This allowed the putting surface to be surrounded by chipping areas and to create a “backboard” behind the green to offer an alternative to approach the back flag location.

### Hole # 15 Par 3

The tee boxes have been re-configured and expanded to 10,887 square feet. The hole increases in length 17 yards by re-positioning the cart path. The new green was reduced to 6,381 square feet. The smaller green allowed us to create chipping areas surrounding the putting surface.

### Hole # 16 Par 4

A new regular tee box has been constructed midway up the slope to provide a better view of the hole. Stone planting beds and a walkway were added by the maintenance staff. The tee boxes comprise 5,980 square feet and offer better separation between tee markers. The fairway has been shifted to the left by removing a tree and a new fairway bunker was added to better define the location of the existing creek from the tees. The new green was enlarged to 4,974 square feet and shifted to the left to lessen the dogleg of the hole. Three greenside bunkers and chipping areas frame the putting surface.



### Hole # 17 Par 3

The tee boxes remain the same size at 5,265 square feet. The new green was expanded to 6,582 square feet. The putting surface was re-designed to be more receptive to tee shots and to allow working the ball near pin locations by various methods. Two greenside bunkers and chipping areas surround the green.

### Hole # 18 Par 5

The hole has been lengthened by 22 yards from a new back tee and remaining tees were expanded to measure 7,170 square feet. For all other tees play will be slightly less as the green moved forward. Two fairway bunkers were added bordering the right side of the fairway and a small fairway bunker has been positioned to define what would normally be considered the left edge of the landing area. The placement of this small bunker creates a 35 yard landing area and is intended to influence club selection and shaping of tee shots. Although additional fairway turf exists left of the small bunker this is not an intended landing area due to the location of mature trees between this area and the green. A small lake and waterfall have been added along the left side of the second landing area to add to the thought process of golfers on their second shot. The new green has been lowered three feet and enlarged to 6,815 square feet. A small greenside bunker guards the front left of the putting surface while two bunkers flank the back pin locations. Chipping areas have also been added surrounding the green.
